Next classes 13-17 are open to best in show championship. 1st and 2nd place in each class go forward.

13. Lead Rein, riders under 10. ponies under 12 2Hh. All unplaced competitors to receive special.

14. Connemara open to registered green passports only! Ridden, led or inland.

15.Mountain and Moreland. Small or Large breeds, Ridden, led or inland.

16.Style and Performance. to be judged on 40% tack and Turnout 60% performance to be ridden Snaffle bridle. Open to any age rider/horse.

17. Veterans. Horses ponies 16+ Ridden, led or inland.

Championship to follow, sashes, rosettes, and prizes in kind to the champion and reserve.

Recommended Horsebox Route to the Showground.

Exit M3 at Junction 4a and follow the signs to the A327 Signposted Blackwater & Yateley. At Roundabout take the 2nd exit onto Signposted Blackwater & Yateley. At Roundabout with the A30 take 2nd Exit onto Cricket Hill lane. In 90 Mts turn left onto Virgo lane. At Roundabout take 1st left onto Monteagle lane. Take 3rd left onto Bridle path and follow to Show Entrance.

All Class's will run under the current BS Rules. All Class's will be run as Single Phase and In the event of insufficient entries, lower prizes may be withheld

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1) All Classes are open to Horses and Ponies.
- 2) It shall be deemed a condition of entry that the organisers, the Landowner and his agents shall not be held responsible or libel for any loss, injury or damage to competitors, onlookers, their property, servants or horses or ponies howsoever caused whilst on the premises.
- 3) No unauthorised persons to enter arenas.
- 4) Riders must wear riding hats to current approved British Standards and with the Chinstrap properly fastened at all times when mounted.
- 5) No horse or pony under 4 years may enter any of the ridden classes.
- 6) The Judge's decision is final.
- 7) No illegal outside assistance by spectators.
- 8) No horse or pony to be ridden by more than one rider in any one class.
- 9) Horses and ponies tied up outside horseboxes and trailers must not be left unsupervised under any circumstances.
- 10) Objections must be made within 15 minutes of the offence and must be accompanied by £100, which will be refunded if the objection is sustained.
- 11) Under no circumstances will entry fees be refunded due to cancellation by competitors (unless accompanied by a doctor or veterinary certificate).
- 12) Yateley Horse Shows reserves the right to cancel classes if insufficient entries.
- 13) Yateley Horse Shows reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry/entries of their discretion.
- 14) Anyone found galloping around the arenas or on the showground will be asked to leave immediately.
- 15) The Judge may disqualify any competitor for misuse of whips or spurs. Whips must not exceed 75cms in length. Schooling whips are not allowed.
- 16) No lunging.
- 17) Competitors are responsible for adhering to their start times.
- 18) Please remove all droppings/hay from the showground
- 19) All dogs to kept on a lead at all times.
- 20) In the event of adverse weather conditions, please check the website, Facebook page, or call the secretary.
- 21) The competition will run under the guidelines of the BSJA Rules & Regulations. All Class's will be run as Single Phase
- 22) A judge's standard may be introduced in any class, at the judge's discretion.
- 23) In the interest of health and safety, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and obey the instructions of the organisers and stewards.
- 24) All Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult.

Any matter not covered by the above will be referred to the organisers whose decision will be final
